

# Dunedin Cup Light - Notice of Race 2010

## 1. Rules

1.1 These series shall be governed by the rules as defined in the current edition of the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), or as modified by the Dunedin Sailing Instructions.

1.2 The following documents also apply:

Notice of Race (this document)  
Dunedin Boat Club Sailing Instruction's 2010  
West Florida PHRF, Inc. class rules, appendix "E", Cruising Class racing.

## 2. Classes

2.1 For "True Cruising", "Race/Cruiser", and "Multihull" boats under 26 feet LWL the class flag is WHITE.

2.2 Spinnakers are not allowed.

## 3. Eligibility

3.1 All sail boats that meet the safety requirements as specified in the rules may participate.

3.2. It is encouraged that all sailors have current ratings for their boats, if they wish to participate.

3.2.1 A WF-PHRF certificate will be honored if it has been issued within the current year.

3.2.2 Race committee will provide a rating if no certificate is available.

## 4. Schedule of Races; Registration; Fees

4.1 One race to be sailed in the "Bay", just north of the Dunedin Fish Pier on October 2nd, 2010. First start will be at 1 PM

4.1.1 Race Detail

Location: just north of the Dunedin Fish Pier.

Course: TBD by Race Committee prior to warning flag. NO GPS coordinates will be issued. Only bearing and distance from each mark. All marks will be visible buoys.

Dates: October 2nd, 2010

Time: 1pm

Number of Races: One race.

4.2 Skipper's meetings (mandatory) will be held at 6 p.m. Friday October 1st, at the Dunedin Boat Club.

4.2.1. Online check in for the race is available at [www.dunedinsails.org/shop.html](http://www.dunedinsails.org/shop.html). But you must be present at the Skippers Meeting.

4.2.2. Telephone check in is available at 727-688-1631 within 72 hours of the race. Please leave the skippers name, boat name, and if it is your first race with us the make, model and year of your boat.

## **5. Committee Boat Assignment and Duties**

5.1. Committee Boat and R/C will be identified at the Skippers Meeting.

## **6. Scoring and Prizes**

6.1 Scoring will be the low point system, based on time-on-time phrf corrections to your elapsed time.

6.2 Prizes: Three (3) boats: 1 prize, four (4) boats: 2 prizes, five (5) or more boats 3 prizes to be awarded.
