FINAL NOTICE OF RACE

26TH ANNIVERSARY DUNEDIN CUP REGATTA

OCTOBER 1-3, 2010

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 The organizing authority is the Dunedin Boat Club (DBC).
- 1.3 Competitors must present a current WFPHRF rating at the time of registration.
- 1.4 WFPHRF Class Rules may be found at www.westfloridaphrf.org

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 Open to any single-hulled boat that holds a current, valid WFPHRF rating; and to all offshore multi-hull yachts that have a current, valid WFPHRF rating.
- 2.2 The term “skipper” is the person, whether or not they are the owner of the boat who is in charge of the boat and will be responsible for its handling and safety; the conduct of its crew while ashore as a guest of the host club. The “skipper” shall be responsible for compliance with the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions.
- 2.3 All boats shall carry a workable VHF radio capable of receiving and transmitting on channels 16 and 72, and receiving weather broadcasts.

- 3.2 The entry fee for the Spinnaker Class, Non-Spinnaker Class, Racer Cruiser and Cruising class is \$60.00 per boat. Payment is by PayPal or checks payable to DUNEDIN BOAT CLUB on or before Wednesday, September 29, 2010 at 2300 hours. Entries after September 29 will be charged \$75 per boat.

4. EVENT FORMAT/SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 4.2 Saturday October 2, 2010: Spinnaker Class, Non-Spinnaker Class and Cruising Class in the Gulf of Mexico N28° 07.719’ W82° 51.228’
1200 First Warning signal.
No starts after 1500 on Saturday, October 2, 2010.

5. CLASSES TO RACE IN THE GULF OF MEXICO

- 5.1 Minimum of three boats to make a class.
- 5.2 Classes are: WFPHRF Spinnaker, WFPHRF Non-Spinnaker, and WFPHRF Cruising. Further divisions of classes may be dictated by the number of entries received.
- 5.3 Divisions will be assigned based on a combination of rating, displacement and sailing characteristics of each boat.
- 5.4 Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted at 0900 on the official notice board on the day it takes effect.

6. COURSES AND RACING AREA

- 6.1 The racing area will be in the Gulf of Mexico.
- 6.2 Courses will be Triangular or Windward/Leeward detailed in the Sailing Instructions.
- 6.3 Final copies of the Sailing Instructions will be available at the Skippers Meeting, October 1, 2010.

7. SCORING

- 7.1 The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A4.1.
- 7.2 Corrected times will be calculated using time on distance based on the boat's WFPHRF rating. Boats racing on the windward/leeward course will use the buoy rating. Boats on the triangle course will RLC rating.

8. PRIZES

- 8.1 Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place for each class.
- 8.2 Additional trophies may be awarded at the discretion of the race organizer.

9. DOCKAGE

Transient slips are available on a first come/first serve basis. Reservations are recommended. Contact Bill Frantz, 727-298-3030. Hail 'Dunedin Municipal Marina' on channel 16.
