

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS  
27<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY DUNEDIN CUP REGATTA  
OCTOBER 28 - 29, 2011  
WINDLASSES/FWSA PRAM RACES  
SUNFISH CLASS RACES  
CLUB 420'S RACES

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

- 2.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located on the bulletin board on the west wall inside of the pram shed.

3. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 3.1 Any changes to the sailing instructions will be posted before 1100 on the day it will take effect.

4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 4.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed on the flagpole outside the pram shed.  
4.2 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 15 minutes' in the race signal AP.

5. SCHEDULE OF RACES

5.1 Dates of racing:

Club 420's - Saturday October 29, 2011

Sunfish - Saturday October 29, 2011

Windlasses/FWSA prams - Saturday October 29, 2011

5.2 Number of races:

Club 420's scheduled for up to five races

Sunfish scheduled for up to three races

Windlasses/FWSA prams scheduled for up to three races

- 5.3 The scheduled time for the first warning signal is 1300 for Club 420's. Other classes and subsequent races to follow.

6 CLASS FLAGS

- 6.1 Club 420's will be signaled with a neon pink class flag.  
Sunfish will be signaled with a yellow flag with a sunfish insignia.  
Windlasses/FWSA prams will be signaled with a purple pram insignia.

7 RACING AREAS

- 7.1 The racing area is located North of the Dunedin Boat Club house.

8 THE COURSES

- 8.1 The diagram in Attachment A shows the courses.  
8.2 No later than the warning signal, the race committee signal boat will display the course to be sailed.

8.3 Courses will not be shortened.

## 9 MARKS

9.1 Club 420's will use solid orange balls

Sunfish will use solid orange balls

Windlasses/FWSA prams will use solid orange balls with a black stripe.

## 10 THE START

10.1 Races will be started using a 3 minute sequence. This changes rule 26.

10.2 The starting line will be between an orange flag on the signal boat and a buoy displaying an orange flag.

10.3 Boats whose warning signal has not been made shall avoid the starting area during

the starting sequence for other races.

10.4 A boat starting later than 2 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start (DNS)

without a hearing. This changes rules A4 , A 5 and 62.

## 11 THE FINISH

11.1 The finishing line will be between the orange flag on the signal boat and a buoy displaying an orange flag

## 12 PENALTY SYSTEM

12.1 The Scoring Penalty, rule 44.1 will apply.

## 13 PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

13.1 Protest forms are available on the official notice board located in the pram shed.

13.2 For each class, the protest time limit is 30 minutes after the race committee signal boat

has docked. The signal boat docking time will be posted on the official notice board.

## 14 SCORING

14.1 The low point scoring system will be used for scoring.

14.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
